- Creation and expansion of wetlands and ephemeral ponds on Gardom Lake Creek adjacent to Musgrave Road
- Creation of three painted turtle nesting sites
- Coordination of invasive weed removal
- Water quality testing above and below the wetlands
- Water quality testing in Gardom Lake
- Educational activities with school groups at the wetlands
- Strong support for the protection of Gardom Lake's watershed on Mallory Ridge
